Regulation (EU) 2021/821

Legal Requirements

The international Wassenaar Arrangement regularly revises the list of dual-use items, i.e. goods (including software and technology) which were produced for civil use but can also be used for military purposes due to their properties (e.g. material characteristics or performance).

The Swiss Federal Act on the Control of Dual-Use Goods, Specific Military Goods and Strategic Goods (Goods Control Act, GCA) and Regulation (EU) 2021/821 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 20 May 2021 govern the approval requirements and procedures for exports, brokering, technical assistance, transit and transfer of dual-use items.

Scope

It was not possible to allocate our products from the EXMAR standard component catalogue to a list in accordance with Annexes 2 and 3 of the GCA and Annex I of Regulation (EU) 2021/821.

Confirmation

The SERTO Group hereby confirms that no export licenses or export permits for dual-use items are required for **any** of the EXMAR standard components (products) in the catalogue.
